

Western New York Foundation awards \$7,000 to LSED

The Western New York Foundation has awarded two grants totaling \$7,000 to Legal Services for the Elderly, Disabled or Disadvantaged of Western New York.

A \$2,000 Trustee's Discretionary Grant was presented to LSED when Richard E. Moot, President of the Western New York Foundation Board of Trustees selected the not-for-profit agency in recognition of the co-location, sharing and consolidating of LSED's office space and equipment with the Bar Association of Erie County's Volunteer Lawyers Project, according to a statement issued by the Western New York Foundation.
